New Amazon region

Amazon Turkey is now available. It's included, so if you'd like to use it just ask and we'll enable it for you.

The available Amazon regions are now: Australia, Belgium, Canada, Egypt, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Netherlands, Poland, Spain, Sweden, Turkey, United Kingdom and United States.

Order detail lines

Discounts on bundles were not reflected in the components once split. This has now been corrected.

Amazon multi-buy promotion discounts now fetched with the order data from Amazon and included in Discount item.

For LiveShip customers, the Fulfilment and Postage costs (where configured) are populated immediately the route is notified.

Download reports

The *SKU for channel*, *Buying price* and *Currency* have been added to "Reports" > "Products/channels download".

The *Refund amount* has been added to "Sales" > "Sold" (download).

Groupon

The tax equivalent to that charged by Groupon to the customer is now calculated and ensures correct handling by LiveShip. The default tax setting has been removed in "Settings" > "Channels" (More settings).

Product catalogue

The performance of the product catalogue page has been greatly improved, especially where you have a large number of channels.

The languages available now mirror the languages of the channels you have enabled, so superfluous ones are no longer shown.
