Two factor authentication

In order to better protect your SurfSeller account email based two factor authentication (2FA) is now available.

It is now Amazon policy that access to Amazon data must be protected by 2FA, so this will be permanently enabled for all SurfSeller accounts shortly. We're working on providing an authentication app based option which will offer an alternative in the future.


2FA is enabled in "Settings" > "User accounts" setting the email 2FA option.
